



Chuppa Pops by Marilyn Dzælmanis

Fun for Kids (of all ages)



These animals were made using Chuppa Chups as the base. Make sure that you only use these sweets as others do not have the same round base.

They were all covered using fondant only. Liquorice can be used to add the accent colours – e.g. black and red.

To cover – roll a 25 gm ball of fondant until smooth then hollow out. Gently ease the ball of paste over the top of the sweet and smooth around the base.

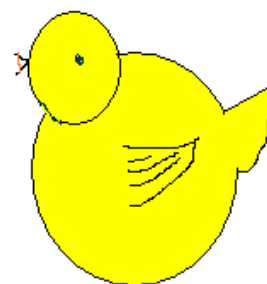
The features are then added. The only exception is the duck where you gently pull out a section for the tail when forming the body.

1. **Duck** – after forming tail – mark wings.

Roll out a 5gm ball of paste to form the head – attach.

Add eyes.

To make the beak make a semi-circle of orange paste, mark to indicate the beak and attach to head.



2. **Owl** – using grey paste – cover body. Whilst paste is still fresh,

use a pair of fine pointed scissors and cut to indicate feathers.

Using yellow paste – cut two small circles for eyes.

Place a smaller black circle in the centre of these.

Make a small carrot shape for the black beak.

For the nightcap – make a cone shape and hollow out to fit the head. Fit over the head at an angle.
