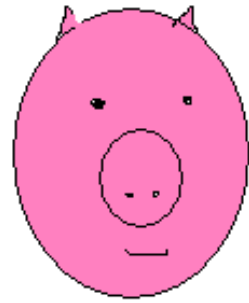
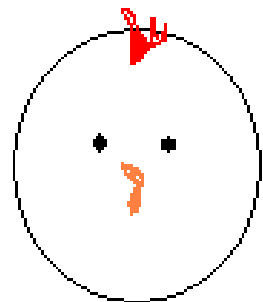




3. **Pig** – using pink paste, cover body. Using 5 gm paste – mould a small circle for nose – not forgetting to mark nostrils – attach. Mark mouth. Make two small eyes using black paste or liquorice. Mould 2 small ears.



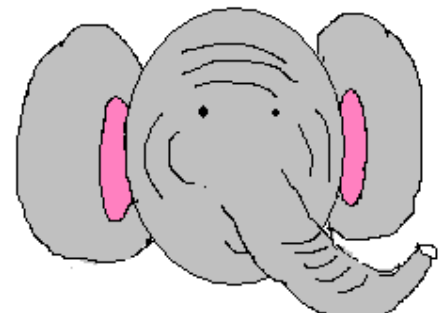
4. **Rooster** – using white paste cover body. Using red paste or red liquorice or fondant, roll out piece of paste and cut to represent comb. Attach to top of head. For beak – mould a carrot shape from orange paste and cut in 2 to represent beak – attach. Using black paste or liquorice – make eyes.



5. **Dog** – can be made any colour you wish. Cover body in same manner. Use a 5 gm ball of paste to form nose – attach. Mark mouth. Add eyes – Wilton ready made eyes are easy to use or make your own using white and black pastes. Mould 2 small tear drop shapes the same colour as your dog and place over eyes to form eyebrows. Ears can be long and droopy or short. Texture the dog to represent fur.



6. **Elephant** – using grey paste, cover body. Using 10 gm paste, mould 2 large ears. To the inside of ears, add a small piece of pink paste or dust with pink chalk. Attach. For the trunk, mould a piece of fondant about 5 gm to form a long carrot shape. Hollow out the smallest end. Attach, not forgetting to mark a series of lines across the width of the trunk. Mark mouth under the trunk. Add two small black eyes. Add texture lines to the top of the head.



These are meant to be fun and stress-less. I'm sure that you will be able to think of other animals that you can also try – e.g. rabbit, cat.
