Modelling Paste (colour of your choice plus green for calyx)

Wires (24/26/28) whatever you prefer

Carnation or blossom cutters

Small scissors, small knife

Powder colours or liquid



Flowers

- Take a piece of wire and put a hook on the end and roll a very small piece of paste to form a small thin sausage to cover the hook.
- Leave to dry.
- Roll out your paste thinly and cut out four shapes using your smallest cutter.
- With a craft knife or a pair of scissors take a petal and carefully make two small cuts into each petal.
- Frill the outside edge of the shape using a toothpick.
